FACTS	WHAT DOES CENTENNIAL ADVISORS, LLC DO WITH YOUR FINANCIAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. Marketing Purposes - Centennial Advisors does not disclose, and does not intend to disclose, personal information with non-affiliated third parties to offer you services. Certain laws may give us the right to share your personal information with financial institutions where you are a customer and where Centennial Advisors or the client has a formal agreement with the financial institution.
